Meeting was called to order by President Mandy Hulet. J. Hulet made a motion. Brown seconded. Motion carried 6-0. Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm.

J. Hulet made a motion to approve the agenda. Brown seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

McCrary made a motion to consent the agenda and approve the April 15th board meeting and approve district bills and obligations. Woodward seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Visitor Communication/Committee Reports

A. Megan Fortner

Spoke and presented to the board her interest in using the school's gym and hosting summer basketball camps for grades 3rd-12th, teaching the basic fundamentals of basketball. The board expressed concern about insurance, waivers, and keeping those who would attend the camp in the gym and not roaming the halls since the school district would be getting ready for the next school year. The board stated they would look these concerns and get back to her.

J. Hulet made a motion to enter into executive session. McCrary seconded. Motion carried 6-0. Executive session entered at 6:16.

Regular meeting resumed at 6:35 with J. Hulet making a motion and Woodward seconding. Motion carried 6-0.

Administrative Reports

A. Superintendent's Report-

Superintendent Pottorff gave reports on damage from the storms that had passed through and DESE money. He stated that KAW Roofing had given in updates and stated that final decisions for the building would be decided on June 28th and that they hope to be done fixing the outside of the building before the end of June.

B. Elementary Principal-

Reported on enrollment and attendance. Activities and meetings that took place at the end of the school year, MAP testing was completed, Elementary Awards, Conservation Poster contest winners and AR reading goals and party.

C. High School Principal-

Enrollment and attendance reports. Organizational highlights regarding activities and trip that had our would-be taking place over the summer. MAP/EOC testing was completed and that 42 students received free day passes for the 1st semester of 2026-2027

Old Business

A. CO-OP with North Davie's for football, softball and baseball

J. Hulet made a motion to approve a CO-OP with North Davie's for football, softball and baseball for the 2026-2027 school year. Woodward seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

B. Curtains for stage

A to Z Theatrical gave a bid for \$11,000 for the front curtain and \$9,500 for the back curtain. Woodward made a motion to go with A to Z Theatrical. McCrary seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

C. Wall Mats

Two bids were received for wall mats. One from BSN and one from Danco. Woodward made a motion to go with BSN. McCrary seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

New Business

A. Approval of District Fees for 2026-2027 school year

Woodward made a motion to approve district fees. J. Hulet seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

B. 2025-2026 Budget was handed out for the board to look over

C. ACES Agreement

Teel made a motion to dissolve the agreement with ACES for the 2027-2028 school year.

Woodward seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

D. Saxton Math- no motion was made

E. Career Ladder

Due to further information the tentative plan is to stick with Career Ladder pending state approval and will be re-evaluated later. McCrary made a motion. Woodward seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

F. QNS Contract

The board agreed to stick with QNS despite the small increase in monthly payment

G. One-hour refresher training

All board members present participated in the one-hour refresher training.

H. Transportation bus inspection review

Superintendent Pottorff stated that the school district would lose money due to not having an employee who could inspect buses but that there was a plan in place to have them inspected.

I. Committee members for COOP meeting

Superintendent Pottorff state that he had a teacher and parent who volunteered to be on the committee and Woodward said he would represent the board at this meeting.

Handed out for approval and changes to be made at the next board meeting.

K. Athletic Handbook

J. Hulet made a motion. Woodward seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

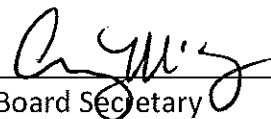
M. Transfer from Fund 1 to Fun 4
